



ADBOND 8388

Solvent based sprayable contact adhesive

DESCRIPTION

ADBOND 8388 is a fast-setting sprayable neoprene rubber base contact adhesive. It adheres very well on laminate, particle board, plywood as well as MDF. It can be used for wood veneer with backer protector. Wait 24 hours before applying lacquer. The first pass of lacquer will have to be sprayed in a thin layer to avoid too much solvent which could impair the adhesion of ADBOND 8388. Consult your technical representative for more information. ADBOND 8388 can also be used for bonding clean sheet metal to plywood and as a primer for polyurethane spray foams when applied to surfaces where they have difficulty adhering. **ADBOND 8388 cannot be applied by roller or brush**.

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

METHOD OF USE

Surfaces must be clean and free from dust, grease, or other contaminants. Spray ADBOND 8388 using pneumatic equipment in thin layer crossed over on both surfaces. Wait 3 to 20 minutes (until it does not transfer to the hand) depending on the temperature and humidity and assemble by pressing the two surfaces together. For best result the adhesive should be used between 18°C and 25°C (65°F and 77°F). For more information on equipment and spray method consult your technical representative.

COVERAGE

MDF or Particle Board = 2 grams dry / ft^2 Plywood = 2.5 to 3 grams dry / ft^2 (according to the porosity)

EQUIPMENT PRESSURE

Tank = 15 to 20 psi Gun = 90 to 100 psi

STORAGE

12 months from date of production in the original unopened containers. Store in dry premises at a temperature between 15°C (59°F) and 25°C (77°F). Storage below or above these temperatures will shorten shelf life. Protect form freezing. Keep in a hermetic closed container to avoid any contamination.

CLEANING

Equipment or overflows can be cleaned with ADSOLVE 6002. Disposal of cleaning solvents and adhesive residues should be sent to a certified hazardous waste disposal company.

CAUTION

Extremely flammable and harmful. Keep away from sources of heat and sparks. Ensure adequate ventilation during spraying. Always consult SDS (Safety Data Sheet) before using the adhesive. For industrial use only. For more information, please contact your technical representative.
